From St. Louis or Springfield, exit I-44 at Exit 169 (Hwy J). Follow Hwy J, 18 miles to Hwy K. Turn right on Hwy K and go through Duke to Wilderness Ridge Resort.

From Jefferson City, Columbia or Rolla, take Hwy 63 south, 23 miles to Hwy K. Follow Hwy K, 10 miles to junction of Hwy K and Hwy J. Turn left on Hwy K. Go through Duke to Wilderness Ridge Resort.

CANOEING, RAFTING & TUBING...

Visit the beautiful, yet undiscovered, **Big Piney River**. Check out the trophy area for smallmouth bass fishing. This is also a great area for turkey and deer hunting!

Wilderness Ridge Resort offers canoeing, rafting, inner tubing, fishing, hiking, camping, RV hookups and cabins. We also have a small store located in the office. We have souvenirs, shirts, snacks, ice and firewood.

Please respect the river. Accidents can happen, so don't be careless. We do not have lifeguards.

CAMPING...

Our campground is located on a beautiful bluff overlooking the Big Piney River. Along with nice breezes, the trees provide plenty of shade on those hot summer days.

Each campsite includes a fire-ring for campfires and a picnic table. You're welcome to bring your own grill or a cooking grate to use with our fire-ring. We do not provide grills or grates. We have some campsites with electric and water hookup.

Our campground also includes a shower house for our campers.



CABINS...

Cabins include linens, dishes, refrigerator, stove, table and chairs. A fire-ring for campfires and a picnic table are also provided. You're welcome to bring your own grill or a cooking grate to use with our fire-ring. We do not provide grills or grates. All cabins have air conditioning and a cold water sink.

CABIN #1:

One large room with a cold water sink in the kitchen area along with two double beds. This cabin is located on the river.

CABIN #2:

Old log cabin built in 1932 that overlooks the river. One large room with two double beds, a futon and a screened-in porch. A cold water sink is located inside the cabin.

CABIN #4:

Two rooms – a living area with a futon and a bedroom with two double beds. A cold water sink is located inside the cabin.

CABIN #5:

Two rooms – a medium size living area with a futon and a bedroom with one double bed. A cold water sink is located inside the cabin.

BUNK HOUSE – FOR LARGE GROUPS:

One very large living area that includes kitchen and fourteen bunk beds. Also has a bedroom with a double bed and a bathroom. Includes air conditioning, heat, hot and cold water.

LODGE HOUSE:

Fully furnished and sleeps six. Living room with fireplace, large kitchen, back deck, two bedrooms and a bathroom. Includes air conditioning, heat, hot and cold water.

The cabins have a shower house close by. All cabins are close to the river.



DEPOSITS...

50% down at the time of reservation. Your deposit will be refunded if you cancel at least 2 weeks before your reservation, minus a \$10 service charge. Bunk House or Lodge House deposit will be refunded if you cancel at least 3 weeks before your reservation, minus a \$20 service charge.

CAMPGROUND & CABIN POLICIES...

- Check-out time is 11:00 am unless other arrangements have been made with the management.
- Check-in time is 4:30 pm.
- No littering – keep the ground and river clean.
- No fireworks or firearms.
- No ATV's or motorcycles.
- No unattended fires.
- Pets must be kept on a leash.
- Please respect others; watch your language.
- As long as you are quiet and do not bother others, there is no curfew. Have a good time and stay up as long as you want!
